Course Objective:

- Understand the complex dynamics of Jammu& Kashmir Politics in the Post Independent Era.
- To explore the implication of the Article 370 and 35-A on the Jammu Kashmir & National Politics.
- To analysis the rise of terrorism, human rights violation and its effects on the minorities in Kashmir.
