**Nature Study** 

**30Marks Internal and 70 marks External**

- **3-** Thirteenth and sixteenth week will be dedicated for the study of natural living and non living things like leaf, plant, stone, tree, animal, birds, architecture etc with colors.

**3 D Clay Modeling** 

- 1- Study of basic shapes with clay like Cube, Ball, Pyramid etc, the purpose of the exercise is introduction of clay application to the student of primary level. (second and fifth week)
- 2- Study of life cast with clay from the replica of hand , leg, ear, nose, lips etc.( eight and eleventh week )
- **3-** Study of quail method , pinching method, slab and throwing methods and baking of pots. (fourteenth and seventeenth week)
