Products like Bamboo Artwork, Bengali Saari, Kangra Paintings, Chamba Rumaal, Toys, processed food products, Handloom and Handicraft products, etc. were the major products that were exhibited during this fair. The Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation, School of Commerce and Management Studies under the extension and outreach initiative of the Central University of Himachal Pradesh took the lead and formed a group of 5 MBA students under the supervision of the teachers to promote the products of the participating rural artisans in the University as well as on various social media platforms.
