NMC-BoS 6.7

To approve the list of subject experts for various academic purposes of the department.

The deliberations held and decisions taken in the BOS as per the Agenda are as follows:

Item MCE-BoS-2.1: Approval of the new courses to be included in the existing course catalogue.

Decision:

It was suggested by the members that some of the proposed courses like MCE 426 Audience Ethnography, MCE 427 Media Practices with Wearable Technologies, MCE 428 Visual Knowledge, MCE 433 Beyond Bollywood: Regional Films in India, MCE 434 Introduction to Data Visualization, MCE 435 New Media and Visual Culture, MCE 436 Media & Popular Culture, MCE 440 Investigative Reporting & Undercover Operations, MCE 442 Defence Reporting for Television shall be further discussed in detail in a brainstorming session by inviting the industry experts and academia to have a wider discourse. The content of the proposed courses shall be developed after the brainstorming session so that the inputs of both industry experts and academia should be incorporated.
