# ACTION TAKEN REPORT (ATR) ON STUDENT'S & ALUMNI FEEDBACK

# 1. Students provided suggestions on teaching-learning:

- (i) Students requested the department to provide hands-on exposure to SPSS Software for skill development to manage and analyse data ATR:
  - (a) Dr Shabab Ahmad, Assistant Professor in the department organized six onehour sessions on SPSS to the MSW students.
  - (b) Faculty members also guided students on a regular basis on "how to make effective presentations using MS Powerpoint"
  - (c) Dr Asutosh Pradhan took sessions on MS Excel and deliberated on the use of spreadsheets and excel application for database development, data management, and data analysis in quantitative research.
