FORMATION OF APEX COMMITTEE ON SPARSH

In order to reiterate its commitment towards creating a sexual harassment free work environment, Central University of Himachal Pradesh has constituted an Apex Committee on Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH), which shall be committed to the elimination of all forms of discrimination against women and shall take proactive steps towards gender sensitization and elimination of sexual harassment. To fulfil the objectives of the University, Apex Committee is dedicated to provide, for all women who fall within its jurisdiction including academic and non-academic staff, students and other employees, a place of work and study free from gender discrimination, sexual harassment and exploitation. SPARSH, CUHP seeks to encourage all employees etc. to express their opinions and feelings about any related problem or complaint of sexual harassment in a freely, responsibly and orderly manner.

FORMATION OF UNIVERSITY COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

As on date of reporting, the University has also formed a University Complaints Committee (UCC) in September, 2017 as per the provisions of SHWW (PPR) Act, 2013 to deal with the complaints, if any.

CUHP is committed to the elimination of all forms of discrimination against women and takes proactive steps towards gender sensitization and elimination of sexual harassment. The SPARSH Committee is fully committed in creating

awareness among the students, faculty and non teaching by conducting various events from time to time, which connects to the heart of students particularly. In this pursuit Dr Manpreet Arora, along with her team which works at all three campuses kept CUHP busy by conducting gender sensitization programmes periodically.

In the beginning of the academic session a detailed presentation was made by the Chairperson in regards to the provisions of Vishaka guidelines relating to sensitization of the workforce at the workplace. The lectures were conducted in all three campuses of CUHP, i.e Dharamshala, Shahpur and Dehra. Frequent online discussions by the committee members are done in their respective online classes to address if any issue was there. As due to pandemic the physical campuses are closed for more than one and a half year, the SPARSH and Gender Champions action committee involving the teaching and non teaching staff at all three campuses was created on 27th January 2021. The members are expected to bring to notice of the core committee if any student or faculty reports any kind of problem during online conduct of the classes.

A unique drive was started in this regard to talk five minutes with students about gender sensitization in each class. A good response in this regard was achieved especially in case of Management students, who came up with various innovative ideas to sensitize the stakeholders at workplace. The committee members periodically discuss in their online classes various gender related issues, causes and their possible solutions to make students aware of such issues.
