NOTICE

Entrance Test for Ph.D.Programmes of Study—2023-24

- **1.** The Central University of Himachal Pradesh invites applications from the eligible candidates/applicants for Entrance Test for Ph.D.Programmesof Study.
- **2.** The application forms will be submitted via ONLINE mode only. Please visit the university website www.cuhimachal.ac.in for more information regarding the process of filling the application form.
- 3. The online portal/link for filling out application forms will be active w. e. f. 22.08.2023 on the university website and the last date for applying is 02.09.2023.
- **4.** The Central University of Himachal Pradesh is a public funded university and follows Government of India Reservation Policy.
- 5. The candidate must have Passed with 55% marks in PG examination in the concerned subject. (For SC/ST/OBC (Non creamy layer)/Divyang candidates there will be relaxation of 5% marks)
- **6.** Eligible applicants shall have to qualify Entrance test which will be conducted by the University. The syllabus for the Entrance test shall be 50% research methodology and 50% subject specific.

7. Minimum Eligibility:

To be eligible, the applicant must have qualified any of the following:

- (i) UGC- JRF
- (ii) UGC-NET
- (iii) UGC-CSIR -JRF
- (iv) UGC-CSIR NET
- (v) ICAR-JRF/SRF
- (vi) ICMR-JRF
- (vii) DBT-JRF
- (viii) SLET
- (ix) Teacher Fellowship Holder
- (x) M.Phil
- (xi) Himachal Pradesh KendriyaVishwavidyalayaShodhPatrataPariksha (HPKVSPP)
- **8.** Admission to Ph.D.programme shall follow a **Two-Stage Process** which will be as follow:
 - **8.1** The entrance test will be of qualifying nature and a minimum of 50% marks (45% for SC/ST/OBC(Non creamy layer)/ Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidates) is required to be scored by each candidate in entrance test for becoming eligible for admission to Ph.D. degree programme. The candidates awarded with JRF shall be exempted from entrance test. All remaining candidates (including those with NET/SLET/Teacher Fellowship Holder/MPhil/ Himachal Pradesh KendriyaVishwavidyalayaShodhPatrataPariksha (HPKVSPP) etc.) are mandatorily required to appear in PhD entrance test. The syllabus of the entrance test shall

comprise of 50% research methodology and 50% subject specific knowledge related content. Entrance test shall comprise of 100 marks with 20% weightage in composite score (Candidates with JRF shall be given 20 marks).

8.2 The candidates who will qualify the entrance test shall move to second stage of selection process. This second stage will include interaction and interview/viva-voce and shall have following weightage given to different components:

The interview/viva-voce shall take into consideration specifically that whether the candidate possesses the research aptitude and competence for undertaking the research work.

8.3 The admission of candidates to Ph.D. programme shall be made on the basis of merit drawn in accordance to above criteria i.e. out of 100 marks (Maximum Composite score)

9. Departmental Standing Committee(DSC)

- **8.1** For making admissions to Ph.D. programme of study, a Departmental Standing Committee (DSC) shall be constituted by each department which shall have following composition:
 - i. Head of the Department Chairman
 - ii. All Professors of the Department Members
 - iii. Senior Most Associate Professor of Department (On Rotation Basis) Member
 - iv. Senior Most Assistant Professor of Department (On Rotation Basis) Member
 - v. Representative/s of SC/ST/OBC/ Women/ PWD, if none of above members (i) to (iv) belong to these categories who may be Professor/ Associate Professor / Assistant Professor from other departments, if required (to be appointed by Vice Chancellor).
- **8.2** The reservation to candidates belonging to different categories in Ph.D. admissions will be made at the departmental level. Initially, the reservation roster for admissions to Ph.D. programme of study shall be made available to each department by the office of the Director (Research). The departments (through its DSC) will maintain proper records of reservation to different categories in Ph.D. programme of study while making admissions in future.
 - a) For complete information regarding eligible research supervisors, Departments/ Centres along with their area/s of specialization/ interest, and <u>number of vacant seats</u> available with them, please visit the university website <u>www.cuhimachal.ac.in.</u>
 - b) The number of vacant seats in a Department/ Centre and the seats to be actually allotted may vary keeping in mind the infrastructural constraints of the University.
 - c) Reservation to various social categories has been done Department/Centre wise strictly in accordance with the Reservation Policy of the Government of India, and its implementation will be the responsibility of the Head/Director of the Department/Centre.
