



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

CSK HIMACHAL PRADESH KRISHI VISHVAVIDYALAYA, PALAMPUR

AND

CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF HIMACHAL PRADESH, DHARAMSALA

This Memorandum of Understanding hereinafter referred to as MoU is signed on this 17th day of November in the year 2023 between the CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya, Palampur – H.P., hereinafter called "CSKHPKV" which expression, unless otherwise provided, shall include its successors and assignees, on the one part and the Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala, District Kangra (Himachal Pradesh)-176215, herein after called "CUHP" which expression, unless otherwise provided, shall include its successor of assignees on the other part.

1. Preamble:

National Laboratories and Universities in terms of research and academic activities. In compliance to this idea, the CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya, Palampur – H.P. and the Central University of Himachal Pradesh (CUHP), established under the Central Universities Act2009, have expressed a desire to join hands for the cause of promotion of quality research and high end science and decided to sign Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to initiate academic and research programmes between the two Institutions in the broad areas of Biosciences and Bioinformatics as per the following terms and conditions:

2. Recitals

- 2.1 AND WHEREAS both the CSKHPKV and the CUHP recognize that they share common goals and are desirous to establish, a cooperative arrangement towards strengthening Indian higher education and research through mutual resource sharing.
- 2.2 AND WHEREAS both organizations are desirous to associate in all other related areas as may be agreed upon for furtherance of knowledge based enterprises, apt technical and management skill for future technology development, exchanging of information and work towards effective Research Institutions-Academia partnerships for Human Resource Development and R&D.
- 2.3 NOW THE PARTIES (CSKHPKV and CUHP) HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND agree to collaborate on collaborative and joint research work in the various areas of mutual interest by entering into this MoU covering the activities as detailed below:

3. Period of MoU and its Extension

- 3.1 This MoU comes into effect from the date of its signing and will remain in force till the completion of five (05) years. Its validity can be extended by mutual agreement between both the parties.
- 3.2 This MoU supersedes all the previous correspondences and discussions, undertakings and agreement between the two parties on the subject pertaining to this MoU.

4. Scope of MoU

- 4.1 The scope of the MoU will be to collaborate for research and teaching in the designated subjects of Animal Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Life Sciences or Physical/Chemical Sciences and any other relevant fields. Both the Parties hereto wish to record the following main areas of cooperation on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
 - 4.1.1 Mutually sharing of infrastructural facility for persuing research and conducting R&D programmes.
 - 4.1.2 Knowledge sharing in the field Animal Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Life Sciences or Physical/Chemical Sciences and any other relevant fields.
 - 4.1.3 Exchange of faculties in regular courses and training programme from both the institutions. For the mutual benefit of the two Institutions, there will be exchange of CSKHPKV and faculty members of the CUHP.
 - 4.1.4 Collaborative and Joint research projects by the CSKHPKV Scientists / FACULTY and faculty members of the concerned schools of CUHP through mutual sharing of the research facilities at CSKHPKV and CUHP.
 - 4.1.5 CSKHPKV and CUHP will work closely to generate appropriately trained manpower in the mutually identified areas of Science & Technology through organization of formal academic curricula, symposia, short-term training courses, etc. TA/DA for scientists and research scholars will be borne by the respective organizations.
 - 4.1.6 Faculty/P.G./Ph.D. Scholars may work in other institution for a short / long period in connection with their research work with prior intimation. They shall be considered on duty with the parent organisation for that period. TA/DA for scientists and research scholars will be borne by the respective organizations.

4.1.7 Faculty will be encouraged to deliver expert lectures/ invited talks at other institution. In such cases TA/DA will be borne by the host institute. These visits/ trainings would be performed with the approval of competent authority.

4.2 Responsibility of both the Universities

- 4.2.1 Both the Universities will recognize each other as an accredited Centre for supervising and guiding and pursuing research, leading to Masters/M.Phil./PhD degree in the designated subjects as mentioned above..
- 4.2.2 Both the Universities will recognize Scientists/Faculty of other University, subject to the fulfilment of eligibility requirements as per the Act, Statutes and Ordinances of the University, as Co-Supervisors for guiding research leading to Masters/MPhil/PhD degrees.
- 4.2.3 Both the Universities will, subject to the fulfilment of eligibility requirements as per the Act, Statutes and Ordinances of the University, confer the status of Adjunct Professor, Adjunct Associate Professor and Adjunct Assistant Professor on scientists/Faculty of other University depending upon their qualifications and designations, involved in collaborative research and teaching with CUHP and CSKHPKV.
- 4.2.4 Both the Universities shall provide access to Library and research facilities to the Scientists/Faculty, Students and PhD scholars of other University and they shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the respective University as applicable to the faculty and research scholars of that University.
- 4.2.5 CSKHPKV will provide research facilities to students (not more than 10 at a time) and CSKHPKV Scientists/Faculty will help in preparation of teaching material for these students. For summer training, the rates applicable to the students of other Universities will be applicable to the students of CUHP.
- 4.2.6 CSKHPKV shall arrange Hostel/Guest House accommodation for students of Central University of Himachal Pradesh coming for summer trainings subject to availability of accommodation and in accordance to the guidelines for accommodation charges by CSKHPKV.

4.3 Collaborative Research Degree (MPhil/PhD) Programme

- 4.3.1 CSKHPKV and the CUHP shall, subject to their rules and regulations and through mutual consultation, evolve a collaborative Research Degree (MPhil/PhD) programme.
- 4.3.2 Modalities of the collaborative research degree programme shall be worked out by the two organizations through mutual consultations and with due regard to the Act, Statutes and Ordinances along with the rules and regulations governing the CSKHPKV and CUHP.
- 4.4.3 The student shall be required to submit 'No Dues Certificate' from the Co-Guide/Co-Supervisor from CSKHPKV/CUHP before submission of thesis.
- 4.4.4 The student shall submit a copy of his/her thesis to the CSKHPKV/CUHP Library.

5. Areas of Collaborative Research

Areas of collaborative research shall be worked out mutually between the two parties keeping in view the research needs and priorities of the two parties and also depending upon the research expertise and research facilities available in the CSKHPKV and the CUHP.

6. Co-ordination & Progress Review Committee (CPRC)

- 6.1 It is agreed that the progress of this MOU shall be monitored by a Review Committee comprising Vice-Chancellor of the CUHP or his nominee and Vice-Chancellor of the CSKHPKV or his nominee through periodic meetings.
- Dean of the College concerned from CSKHPKV and Dean of the School concerned from CUHP would be the coordinators for activities under this MoU.

7. Financial Terms

7.1 There shall be no financial obligations on the part of the CSKHPKV and CUHP. Expenditures related to sample preparation and experimentation would be borne by the parent Institution of students/faculty.

No Liability Clause

- 8.1 CSKHPKV shall not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever, resulting due to implementation of any technology at the premises of CUHP or CSKHPKV or due to testing of the same at the premises of CUHP or CSKHPKV.
- 8.2 CUHP shall not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever, resulting due to implementation of any technology at the premises of CUHP or CSKHPKV, or due to testing of the same at the premises of CUHP or CSKHPKV.

9. Confidentiality Clause

- 9.1 Both the parties acknowledge the confidentiality of the information, which may be transferred between the parties or obtained or developed during the course of this exchange from time to time as being essential to this MoU and agree not to disclose the same to any third party. However, each party shall be free to disclose this information as is:
 - 9.1.1 In the public domain at the time of disclosure.
 - 9.1.2 Required to be disclosed by official authorities in accordance with applicable law or regulation.
- 9.2 While the parties agree to co-operate and otherwise act in good faith with the view to the successful implementation, there is no financial binding on either party. This MoU is intended to mutual understanding of the parities hereto as at the date thereof.
- 9.3 Any notice, request or other communication required or permitted to be given under this MoU shall be in writing and shall be delivered in person or by recognized courier service or facsimile, or to the authorized persons of two organisations to be notified separately.
- 9.4 Each of the parties recognizes that the successful implementation of this MOU to the mutual satisfaction and benefit of both the parties will require a significant degree of cooperation and good faith on behalf of both the parties. Each of the parties resolves to act in good faith and in accordance with the spirit of this MOU to implement the provisions in accordance with the mutual desire and in the interests of the parties.
- 9.5 Both the parties undertake not to transfer, for any consideration to be received by it, the know-how/data obtained through this MoU to any other party in any manner whatsoever without prior written approval of each other whether within and beyond

the period of this MoU. Both the parties shall take all necessary measures to ensure that the knowledge/data obtained under this MoU is not passed on or disclosed to any third party.

9.6 While the parties agree to co-operate and otherwise act in good faith with the view for successful implementation, there is no financial binding on either party. This MoU is intended to mutual understanding of the parities hereto as at the date thereof.

10. Operational Clause:

10.1 The proposed activity to be taken under the Memorandum of Understanding will required to be approved by the Heads of the respective Universities before undertaking the same.

11. Publications

- Publications, if any, in respect of the development of the know-how as envisaged with the prior mutual consent of the two parties shall be in the names of the investigators. Prior publications will be avoided where a patent or patents may possibly be taken.
- Publications, if any in respect of the said studies will be with the prior mutual consent of CSKHPKV and CUHP and shall be in the names of both the parties suitability acknowledged by CSKHPKV /CUHP.
- 11.3 Prior publications will be avoided where a patent or patents may possibly be taken.

12. Protection & Disposition of Ownership of Intellectual Property Rights

- 12.1 The ownership of all Background Information and Background Intellectual Property Rights generated by the parties prior to the MoU shall rest with the respective parties. However, parties shall have right to use such Background Information and Background Intellectual Property Rights for the purposes of the R&D work performed under the MoU.
- 12.2 All Foreground Information and Foreground Intellectual Property Rights created during the R&D work performed under the MoU shall be owned jointly by the parties.

- Parties to this MoU shall confer and consult each other regarding filing of Intellectual Property Rights applications including patent applications covering Foreground Information and share equally the attendant expenditure related to filing, prosecution, grant, maintenance etc. of the same.
- 12.4 In the event of any extraordinary situation including infringement suits filed by third parties, parties shall initiate any action in mutual consultation and agreement.

13. Patent & Patent Infringement

- 13.1 If the know-how developed as a result of a study undertaken under this MoU leads to a patent or patents being taken, the parties hereto shall mutually agree whether or not to apply for a patent/s and if so in which country. Patents taken, if any, will be in joint names of the two parties. The cost of taking out a patent shall be borne by CSKHPKV and CUHP.
- In the event of any claim or action being brought against either party to this MoU alleging infringement of a patent of a third party, the parties hereto shall mutually decide whether to defend the claim or not. The cost of defence against any such claims or action shall be borne by the two parties hereto.
- 13.3 In the event of patents being filed, out of the research work of a student working at CSKHPKV for MPhil/PhD thesis under the sole supervision of scientist(s) from the CSKHPKV, the CUHP shall have no claim to IPRs.
- In the event of patents being filed, out of the research work of a student working at CUHP for MPhil/PhD thesis under the sole supervision of faculty member(s) of the CUHP, the CSKHPKV shall have no claim to IPRs.
- 13.5 In the event of a patent being filed, out of the research work of a student working at CSKHPKV for MPhil/PhD thesis under the joint supervision of the scientist(s) and faculty member(s) of the CUHP, the cost of patenting and any monetary benefits accruing subsequent of filing and maintaining the patents will be shared by CSKHPKV and CUHP on equal basis.

13.6 In the event of a patent being filed out of the collaborative research work between the faculty members of CUHP and the scientists of CSKHPKV the cost of patenting and monetary benefits accruing subsequent to filing and maintaining of the patents will be shared by CUHP and CSKHPKV on equal basis.

14. MoU and its Amendments

14.1 This MoU shall be the principal repository of the terms and conditions agreed to between the parties and no amendment thereof shall take effect or be binding on both the parties unless such amendment is authorized by them and is recorded in writing and signed by the duly authorized representatives of both the parties.

15. Termination

- 15.1 In case it is found by the two parties that the desired objectives cannot be achieved due to any reason(s) whatsoever, this MoU will be treated as terminated by a mutually agreed procedure without any liability on either of the party.
- 15.2 However the MPhil and PhD students admitted under the collaborative research supervision shall continue to be governed by the same terms and conditions till the completion of their degrees in accordance with the Act, Statutes and Ordinances alongwith the rules and regulations governing the CSKHPKV and CUHP.

16. Force Majeure

16.1 Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligation\
under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events, such as, but not limited to Acts of God, War, Flood, Earthquakes, Strike(s), Lockout(s), Epidemics, Riots, Civil commotion etc provided on occurrence and cessation of such events, the party affected by these shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence and cessation. If the majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

17. Arbitration

17.1 Except as otherwise provided elsewhere in the MoU, in the event of any dispute or difference relating to, arising from or connected with the MoU such dispute or difference shall be resolved between the parties by mutual consultation and to the satisfaction of both the parties.

- 17.2 If amicable settlement cannot be reached within 30 days from the date of the occurrence of the dispute, the matter under dispute shall be finally settled without recourse to the courts, in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and amendments thereto, if any.
- 17.3 The Arbitration shall be conducted by the Arbitrator(s) appointed by the mutual consent of both the parties in accordance with the Rules of the said Act. The arbitral award shall be final and binding. The arbitration proceedings shall be held at Dharamshala.

18. Hold Harmless

- 18.1 The CSKHPKV agrees to hold CUHP harmless from any claim or damages arising from the CSKHPKV performance of work under this contract. CSKHPKV shall also hold CUHP harmless without any limitation from any claims or damages raised or damages suffered by the CSKHPKV.
- The CUHP agrees to hold CSKHPKV harmless from any claim or damages arising from the CUHP's performance of work under this contract. CUHP shall also hold CSKHPKV harmless without any limitation from any claims or damages raised or damages suffered by the CUHP.
