Prof. Mahesh Kulharia could not attend the meeting due to his prior commitments and unavoidable reasons and were granted leave of absence.

- 3. The Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Academic Council and after introduction of the external and internal members, highlighted the university's significant achievements and ongoing initiatives. The Central University of Himachal Pradesh has been accredited with A+ grade by NAAC with CGPA score of 3.42 and subsequently accorded Graded Autonomy by the UGC.
- 4. The Central University of Himachal Pradesh has become leading University in implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The University has adopted multiple entry and exit options at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels, undertaken extensive curriculum reforms, and developed a diverse course basket comprising approximately 150 courses. These include interdisciplinary, value-added, ability enhancement, and skill-based courses, all of which integrate the Indian Knowledge System (IKS). The Vice-Chancellor apprised the university's adoption of the Academic Bank of Credits, facilitating easy transfer of credits for all students, and highlighted the recent evaluation reforms that balance theoretical, practical, and skill-based assessments, the use of innovative pedagogies by faculty members in line with NEP-2020 recommendations has been a cornerstone of the university's teaching approach.
- 5. The Vice-Chancellor further informed the Academic Council that the university has made significant advancements in Research and Collaboration, evidenced by the signing of notable MoUs with prestigious national and international institutions, including ISRO, IRCTC, and CSIR. Additionally, the university's faculty and students have achieved remarkable success, with a significant increase in the number of students qualifying for UGC-NET/JRF and a substantial improvement in student placements.
- 6. The Vice-Chancellor apprised the Academic Council that the Central University of Himachal Pradesh is the only university outside of Jammu & Kashmir that is actively promoting and offering courses in the Dogri language. To further this initiative, a committee has been constituted, comprising 10 Vice-Chancellors, under the chairmanship of our Vice-Chancellor. The Academic Council was also informed that the construction of the Dehra Campus is in full swing, and the next session is expected to commence from there. Additionally, the University has prepared and launched its Vision Document 2030.
- 7. The Vice-Chancellor also apprised the Academic Council about the establishment of the Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence with support from the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, as well as the university's leadership in implementing 33 modules out of

44 of the SAMARTH portal of the Government of India. The university has also been entrusted with critical projects such as the study of the "Khelo India" program, culminating in a comprehensive report.

Further, the Vice-Chancellor shared updates on the internationalization of education at the university, including upcoming MBA joint degree programs with Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP), and collaborations with universities in Taiwan and Nepal. The Vice-Chancellor also apprised the Academic Council about university's accomplishments in research, including the receipt of over Rs. 15 crore in grants, a growing number of Scopus and Web of Science publications, and 23 registered patents. Also, the university has hosted significant events, such as the International Yoga Day 2024 and the Inter-University Women Power lifting Championship.

8. The Academic Council was also apprised that the Vice-Chancellor has been appointed as a member of the Governing Council of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). The Vice Chancellor has been invited as the Chief Guest for passing out parade of the Cadets of National Defence Academy, Khadarwasla. Furthermore, the Vice-Chancellor has been honored with the Pragya Pravah Samman by Banaras Hindu University and the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Commerce and Management Association of Himachal Pradesh.

Thereafter the Vice-Chancellor invited the Registrar to take up the agenda items.

The copy of the University Prospectus 2024-25 is placed at **ANNEXURE-38.3(A)** for kind perusal of the Academic Council.

As per Statute 14(d) the power to frame such regulations and rules consistent with the Statutes and Ordinances regarding the academic functioning of the University, discipline, residence, admission, award of fellowship and studentships, fees, concessions, corporate life and attendance is vested with the Academic Council of the University. As such, the Prospectus of the University for the Academic Year 2024-25 for admission to various Certificate/Under Graduate/Post-Graduate Programmes was required to be considered and approved by the Academic Council.

Keeping in view the fact that the admission process could not commence until the prospectus was approved by the competent authority, i.e., the Academic Council, and it was not feasible to convene a meeting of the Academic Council promptly, the Vice-Chancellor approved the University Prospectus 2024-25 by exercising the powers vested in him under sub-section (3) of Section 11 of the Central Universities Act, 2009. This approval was granted in anticipation of the Academic Council's subsequent ratification.

Therefore, the matter was placed before the Academic Council for approval/ratification of the decision taken by the Vice-Chancellor in the matter.

The Academic Council ratified/approved the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for preparing prospectus 2024-25 also accorded its approval to the University Prospectus for the year 2024-25

Item No. 38.5:

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding reconstitution of the Apex Committee and University Complaint Committee for Sensitization, Prevention, and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH) at Central University of Himachal Pradesh for its ratification and approval.

In accordance with the provisions contained under Ordinance No. 21., the university has reconstituted the Apex Committee and University Complaint Committee dealing with Sensitization, Prevention, and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH) vide notification no: 1-4/हि.प्र.के.वि./शे./2010/खंड-III/7616-27 दिनांक 27.12.2023 [Annexure-38.5(A)] to ensure the effective implementation of SPARSH policies across the university, ensuring a safe and harassment-free environment in the University Campus.

The matter was placed before the Academic Council for ratification and approval.

The Academic Council ratified/approved the decision taken by the Vice-Chancellor in this regard and further recommended to the Executive Council.

Item No. 38.6:

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding ratification/approval of Student Grievance Redressal, Teaching Grievance Redressal Committee and Non-Teaching Grievance Redressal Committee in the University.

The University Grants Commission (Redressal of Student Grievances) Regulations, 2023, published under Notification Number F.1-13/2022 (CPP-II) dated April 11, 2023, in the Gazette of India, supersede the previous University Grants Commission Regulations, 2019. The Central University of Himachal Pradesh has adopted these University Grants Commission (Redressal of Student Grievances) Regulations, 2023 vide Item No 61.1 in its 61st meeting of the Executive Council held on 31st May, 2023. The Academic Council is further apprised that these Grievance committees are also mentioned in University Ordinance 28 dealing with "Employees and Students' Grievances Redressal Committee". The University has constituted Student Grievance Redressal, Teaching Grievance Redressal Committee and Non-Teaching Grievance Redressal Committee vide notification no: 1-4/CUHP/Acad/2010/Vol-III dated 07.03.2024 [Annexure-**38.6(A)]** in compliance to these regulation and Ordinance 28. The tenure of members in the Student Grievance Redressal Committee,

Teachers' Grievance Redressal Committee, and Non-Teaching Staff Grievance Redressal Committee is not specified in University Ordinance 28. While the term of the Chairperson, members, and special invitees of Students Grievance Committee is clearly outlined in the University Grants Commission (Redressal of Student Grievances) Regulations, 2023 the tenure for the Teachers' Grievance Redressal Committee and Non-Teaching Staff Grievance Redressal Committee remains undefined.

Therefore, the matter was placed before the Academic Council to:

- 1. Outline and determine the tenure of the Teaching Grievance Redressal Committee and Non-Teaching Staff Grievance Redressal Committee.
- 2. Approve and ratify the constitution of the abovenotified Committees by the University.

The Academic Council ratified and approved the constitution of the above notified Committees by the University. The Academic Council also fixed the tenure of the Teaching Grievance Redressal Committee and Non-Teaching Staff Grievance Redressal Committee as three years and further recommended to Executive Council for its approval.

Item No. 38.7:

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding normalization of credits score (marks) obtained by the students under Swayam courses as per university credits score (marks) format for ratification and approval.

In pursuance of this Notification, the Vice-Chancellor, under powers vested in him under section 11(3) of the Central Universities Act, 2009, constituted the Committees as per Clause 10 & 11 of the University Grants Commission (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018. The University notified the Committees of the Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) and the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP). After the completion of the term of the above committees, the University reconstituted the Committees of the Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) and the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) vide Notification F.No. 1-4/CUHP/Acad/2010/Vol-III/3726-36 dated

24.06.2024 and F.No. 1-4/CUHP/Acad/2010/Vol-III/4281-91 dated 19.07.2024, respectively [ANNEXURE-38.8(A) & (B)].

The matter was placed before the Academic Council for its ratification and approval.

The Academic Council ratified and approved the above notified committees.

Item No. 38.9:

It can engage in policy research, advocacy, and consultancy, influencing systemic changes that address gender disparities at institutional and societal levels. The Centre will enrich the educational experience, contribute to the societal change, and position CUHP as a leader in promoting gender equality and women's development in Himachal Pradesh and beyond.

Keeping in view the above and the academic interest of the narishakti the matter was being placed before the Academic Council for approval.

The Academic Council after deliberation on the matter approved the proposal to rename the "Women Cell (Mahila Prakosht)" as the "Centre for Women Studies and Development (CWSD)." The establishment of the Centre for Women Studies and Development was endorsed as a significant step forward in promoting gender equality and women's empowerment at the university and beyond and further recommended to Executive Council for its approval.

The Department of Commerce was established in September 2023 and has initiated two programs starting from the academic session 2023-24: a two-year postgraduate program, Master of Commerce (M.Com), and a Doctorate program, PhD in Commerce. The course structures for both programs have been approved by the Board of Studies of the Department of Commerce and the School Board of the School of Commerce and Management Studies.

Programme Detail:

Master of Commerce (M.Com)

Master of Commerce (M.Com) is a two-year, four-semester postgraduate program designed to prepare students for leadership roles and successful business ventures within a complex and competitive global business environment.

Eligibility: B.Com/B.Com (Hons.)/BBA/BA (with Economics or Math/BBS or B.Voc in Marketing or retails or financial services, from a recognized Indian or Foreign University or an equivalent examination with at least 50% marks an equivalent grade (For candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwD category, the minimum

eligibility is 45% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination as per the Program-Specific Eligibility.)

- Number of Seats: 33 plus 5 under Self Finance
- Credit Requirements: 80-100 Credits (20 Credits each semester)
- Duration: 2 years (four semesters) with multiple entry and multiple exit options. (Certificate course in case of exit after first semester, PG Diploma after second semester.
- Selection Criteria: On the basis of merit of CUET-PG/as per CUHP Norms.

PhD in Commerce

PhD in Commerce will be a full time doctoral program offered by the department to inculcate the research scholars with basic, applied, and analytical knowledge associated with business and management and to apply their acquired knowledge and skills to promote inquiry, discover solutions, generate new ideas, and communicate their research. The research scholar has to pass rigorous six months course work and will explore and conduct research ethically and as per global standard on the issues concerning locals or national importance.

Eligibility:

- Master's degree in Commerce discipline with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade (a relaxation of 5% marks for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/ Differently-Abled candidates).
- Must have qualified either UGC-NET (Including JRF)/SLET/ GATE/Teacher Fellowship Holder/M. Phil/Himachal Pradesh Kendriya Vishwavidyalaya Shodh Patrata Pariksha (HPKVSPP) or any other eligibility criterion as notified by UGC from time-totime.
- Credit Requirements: 120 Credits
- Selection Criteria: As per CUHP Ordinance
- Duration: 3-6 years (one year relaxation to female candidates).

The matter was placed before the Academic Council for its consideration and approval.

The Academic Council after deliberations at length, considered and approved the above matter.

Item No. 38.34:

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding starting Bachelor of Commerce i.e B.Com (Honors/Research) program in the Department of Commerce, SCMS from the academic session 2024-25 for its consideration and approval.

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, during a meeting with faculty members of the department, suggested starting the Bachelor of Commerce i.e. B.Com (Honors/Research) undergraduate program from the academic session 2024-25. In this context, the matter was discussed with faculty members in departmental meeting and In response, the matter was discussed in a departmental meeting, and it was decided that the department would initiate the 4-year Bachelor Commerce i.e. B.Com (Honors/Research) undergraduate program starting from the academic session 2024-25. The proposal was subsequently put before the university authorities, and the Registrar, vide office letter No. 3-4/CUHP/Academic/2010/3343 dated 31st May 2024 [Annexure-38.34(A)], accorded administrative approval to start the B.Com (Honors/Research) program from the academic session 2024-25. The matter was further placed before the Board of Studies in its second meeting held on June 7, 2024, and in the School Board meeting held on June 25, 2024, for consideration and approval.

Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) Honors/Research is a four years under graduate program designed as per the National Education Policy 2020 following flexible choice-based credit system and multidisciplinary approach and providing multiple entry exit options to the students.

- Eligibility: Intermediate or (10+2) Examination in any discipline, from recognized Examination Board
- Number of Seats: 33 plus 5 under Self Finance
- Credit Requirements: 160-180 Credits (20 Credits each semester)
- Duration: 4-7 years (eight- semesters) with multiple entry and multiple exit options. (Certificate course in case of exit after completing one year, Diploma in case of exit after completing two years and B.Com in case exit after three years.
- Selection Criteria: On the basis of merit of CUET-UG or as per CUHP Norms.

The duly approved proposal to start the 4 years Bachelor of Commerce i.e B.Com (Honors/Research) under graduate program from the academic session 2024-25 was placed before the Academic Council for its consideration and approval.

The Academic Council after deliberations at length, considered and approved the above proposal.

Item No. 38.35:

To place before the Academic Council the Annual Report 2023-24 of the University for the period from 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024.

It is apprise to the Academic Council that the University has prepare Annual Report 2023-24 of the University for the period from 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024 as , several matters of academic importance are included in the Annual Report. Therefore the draft of Annual Report is placed at **ANNEXURE 38.35(A)** for its consideration and approval.

The Academic Council approved the draft Annual Report of the University for the period 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024 and further recommended to Executive Council for its approval.

It is apprised to the Academic Council that in order to incept the recommendations and guidelines of NEP 2020 in the form of an Ordinance of the University, it was placed before the standing ordinance committee of the University constituted vide office order no dated . The committee after deliberations has prepared a drafted Ordinance for implementation of provision of National Education Policy -2020. The draft Ordinance is placed at **Annexure** 38.36(A) For kind perusal and approval of the Academic Council.

The Academic Council observed that the University has adopted the NEP-2020 guidelines issued by the UGC from time to time. These guidelines are also required to be incorporated in the University ordinances. To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding provision of Golden Chance for the Students having F Grade in the University for decision.

The Academic Council is apprised that the Students of the University through CP GRAM portal are representing for Golden Chance Opportunity specifically for the F grade subjects. The copy of the said Public Grievance is placed at Annexure-38.38(A) for kind perusal of the Academic Council. In this context, it is also apprised that earlier, subsequent to the decision of the Academic council taken vide Item No 26.3 of its 26th meeting held on 20.03.2020, the University had approved to give one time Golden Chance to UG/PG/Diploma/Certificate Course students. It was also approved therein that Rs. 2000/- per course and maximum of 5000/- fee shall be charged from the students with directions to Controller of Examination to frame modalities and notified the same with the approval of Vice-Chancellor.

The said decision of the Academic Council is attached at Annexure for kind perusal of the Academic Council.

The above matte was placed before the Academic Council for decision.

The Academic Council after deliberations at length, approved to grant a one-time Golden Chance for students of the University with F grades in larger Academic interest. The Controller of Examination is directed to frame the modalities and notify the same with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor. This decision shall not be treated as a precedent for future cases.

Item No. 38.39:

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding Court Case filed by Ms. Navneet Kaur against the University (CWP no 4615/2024) before Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh regarding Non declaring of Result of PhD programme course in Department of Library and Information Science.

The Academic Council is apprised that the University Employee namely Ms. Naveent Kaur, Professional Assistant has filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh vide CWP No 4615/2024 titiled Ms. Navneet Kaur vs CUHP regarding declaration of Result of PhD programme course in Department of Library and Information Science. The fact of the case are appended below:

The petitioner is permanent employee of the respondent university and presently holding the post of Professional Assistant on regular basis. As of now, the petitioner has put in 12 years of service in the university. The university vide notification No. DIR (Research)/2-7/CUHP/2016 dated 02.07.2018 issued notification for admission for PhD programme of study including admission Department of Library and Information Sciences. Since, intended to pursue PhD programme in Library Sciences, she submitted application dated 03.08.2018 for permission/NOC for applying in PhD programme at respondent university. The respondent university issued NOC for applying in PhD programme at respondent university vide No. 7-17/CUHP/Estt./2011/3689-91 dated 07.08.2018. Subsequent upon her application, respondent university also sanctioned her study leave for 180 days for the period from 11.02.2019 to 09.08.2019 vide office order No. 7-17/CUHP/Estt./2011/1331-1333 dated 06.03.2019.

petitioner was enrolled for PhD programme of study in Library Sciences vide enrolment No. COE/2-2/PhD/CUHP/2018/21/6500-6503 dated 19.03.2019.

As per prevailing provisions of rules for the PhD (Ordinance No. 42), the petitioner was required to complete her Course Work which is mandatory for PhD as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.PHIL./PH.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2016 with in the period from February, 2019 to February, 2020 since, she was enrolled in PhD on 19.03.2019. As per record the petitioner did not complete the mandatory required Course Work successfully within the prescribed period and at this condition the provision of prevailing ordinance No. 42, clause 10.1.

It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner also proceeded on maternity leave during the period from 09.10.2019 to 05.04.2020 vide office order No. LIB/2-3(NK)/CUHP/15/696 dated 16.10.2019.

It is pertinent to mention here that as per provisions contained under clause 10.01(a), the name of PhD scholar shall automatically stands removed for the rolls of the university, if, he/she:-

(a) Does not clear the course work within first two semesters of the admission to PhD programme.

Accordingly, the Controller of Examination Branch of the university placed the entire matter before the Vice-Chancellor. The copy of the proposal is placed at The Vice-Chancellor directed the Controller of Examination to place the entire matter before him which was placed accordingly as per. As per order of the Vice-Chancellor, the head of the department of Library and Information Sciences was directed for the following vide letter No. COE/2-2/CUHP/2021/11744-45 dated 20.07.2021.

- i. Course Code LIS-401 answer book should be gotten evaluated from the Department at the earliest.
- ii. Internal Assessment of LIS-401 & LIS-509 should be submitted by the Department at the earliest.
- 2. It is also submitted that the Director (Research) vide letter No. Director(Research)/2-7/CUHP/2016/1902-04 dated 03.09.2021 addressed to Head of the Department, Library and Information Sciences requesting to place the entire matter before the School Board, Board of Studies, Research Degree Committee, Academic Council and the Executive Council of the university.

Accordingly the department of Library and Information Science has placed the matter before their Board of Studies and School Board in its 8th meeting and the school board has approved to declare the pending result of Ms. Navneet Kaur so as to enable her to complete her to complete PhD programme in Department of Library and Information Science. The minutes of the 8th School Board of the School of Mathematics, Computers and Inforamtion Sciences are already placed before this Academic Council for approval at Item No 38.28 it is pertinent to inform the Academic Council that in the meanwhile, the University has submitted the reply as per aforesaid factual position, before the Hon'ble High Court of the Himachal Pradesh in the instant writ petition filed by Ms. Navneet Kaur, Professional Assistant.

The above matter was placed before the Academic Council for information ratification, approval and decision.

The Academic Council after deliberations at length, considered and approved that as per approval/recommendations of the 8th meeting of the School Board of the School of Mathematics, Computers& Information Sciences (Item No 38.28 of this Academic Council meeting). The result of Ms. Navneet Kaur be declared and the same be forwarded to the counsel of the University for placing the same before High Court of Himachal Pradesh in the referred CPW No 4615/2024.
