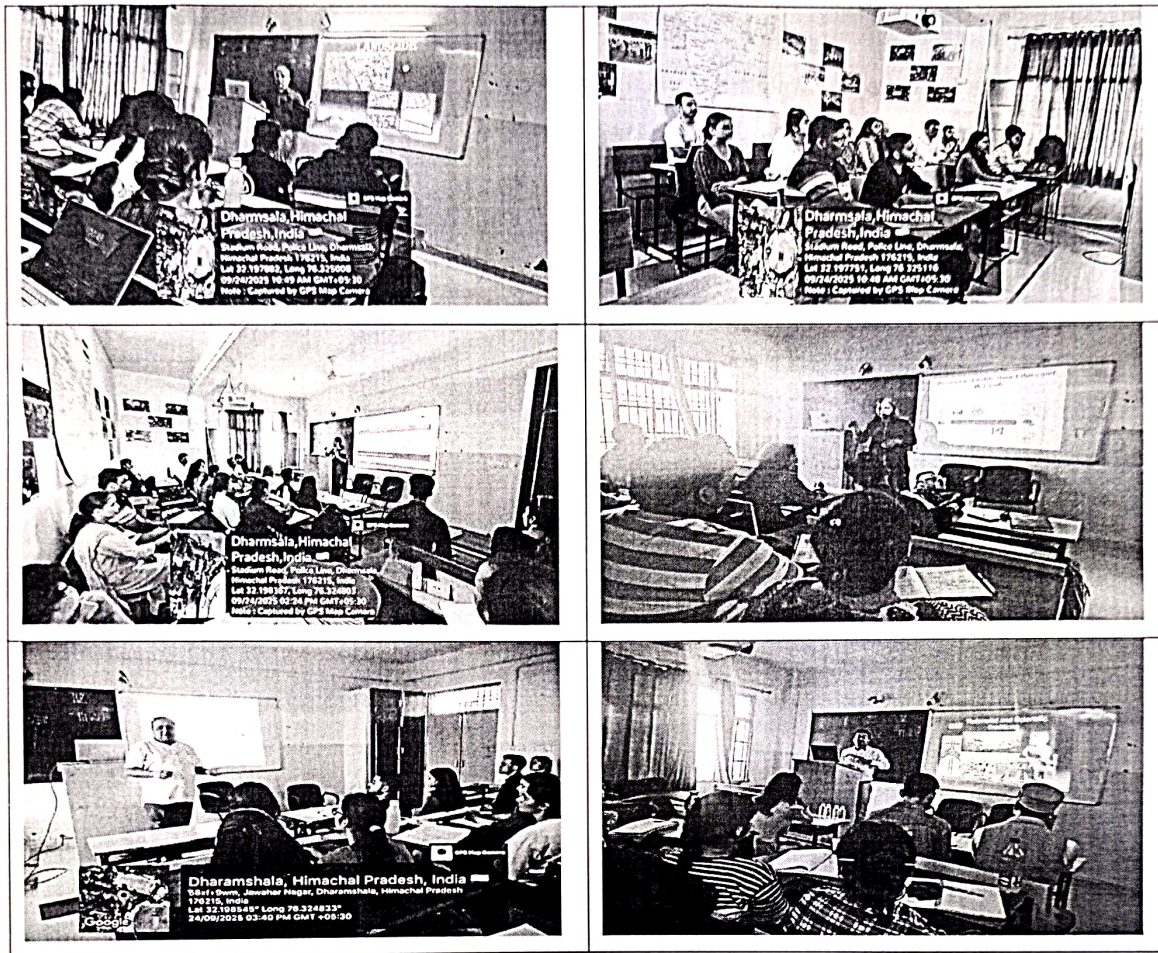

Event Report: One-Week Workshop on Research Methodology for Research Scholars

A one-week workshop on Research Methodology for Research Scholars was successfully organized from September 22 to 26, 2025, at CR-3, Dhauladhar Parisar-II. The workshop aimed to enhance research capabilities by providing scholars with a thorough understanding of research methods, academic writing, and ethical research practices. Eminent faculty members with extensive expertise in their respective fields conducted the sessions, offering both theoretical knowledge and practical guidance.

Day 1 – September 22, 2025

The workshop began with an Inaugural Session and Ice-Breaking Activity, creating an engaging environment for participants. Prof. Pardeep Nair, Director, Research, led a session on the Research Eco-System in the University, sharing insights into institutional research frameworks and guiding scholars on navigating complex academic environments. Prof. Dimple Patel delivered a session on Academic Resources for Learning and Research, providing detailed guidance on library resources, databases, and digital research tools. The afternoon session on Indian Knowledge and Research Agenda was conducted by Prof. B. C. Chauhan, emphasizing the integration of traditional knowledge systems with contemporary

The day concluded with a briefing by Prof. Mohinder Singh, summarizing key learning's and addressing queries.

Day 3 – September 24, 2025

The third day covered environmental research and academic writing skills. Prof. Ambrish Kumar Mahajan, a Senior Professor with expertise in disaster management, delivered a session on Himalayan Disasters and Resilient Infrastructures, offering insights into disaster mitigation, resilient planning, and sustainable infrastructure. Dr. Prativa Shree conducted a session on Research Report Writing, providing practical guidance on report structuring and presentation. Dr. Manpreet Arora explored Qualitative Research and its Dimensions, emphasizing methodological rigor and data interpretation. Dr. Krishna Kumar Verma concluded the day with a session on Research Publication and Ethics, focusing on responsible research practices and publication standards.

Day 4 – September 25, 2025

Advanced research skills were addressed on the fourth day. Prof. Dipankar Sharma led a session on Writing Review Articles, demonstrating critical synthesis of literature. Dr. Bal Mukund Pandey discussed the Research Philosophy of Deen Dyal Upadhaya, linking philosophical insights with research methodology. Dr. Divya V. Nair introduced ICT Tools for Academic Writing and Research, highlighting digital tools that improve efficiency, accuracy, and productivity. The day concluded with a session briefing, consolidating key takeaways and practical applications.



Day 5 – September 26, 2025
