

## Report on the International Fact Check Day Celebration Event, Department of JCW, Central University of Himachal Pradesh & IQAC, CUHP

Department of JCW, Central University of Himachal Pradesh has organized an event to celebrate International Fact Check day on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2018 at the Temporary Academic Block I. . Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala. Prof. Pradeep Nair, the Dean, School of Journalism, Mass Communication & New Media inaugurated the event and briefed the students on the importance role journalism students should play in educating the community around them to be more information literate as part of fighting the misinformation menaoe.

Mr. Harikrishnan B, Assistant Professor, Department of JCW briefed the students about the importance of the international fact check day. During the session, a fact-check game in which students were presented with news claims which they had to fact check real time and decide about the veracity of the claims. The game was interactive where the participants interacted with the claims projected with an LCD projector and marked their responses using an interactive web interface accessed through their smartphones. 40 students from the two departments under the School of Journalism, Mass Communication and New Media joined the game event to showcase their fact-checking skills. Dr. Harsh Mishra, Assistant Professor, Dept of JCW briefed the students about the various fact checking skills needed for journalists during the event. Faculty members from both departments under the School were present during the event.
