Department of JCW, Central University of Himachal Pradesh has organized a one day workshop on Feature Writing on 19th October 2018 in which Prof. Mukul Srivatava, Professor, Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, University of Lucknow trained the students under the two departments under the School of Journalism, Mass Communication & New Media about different techniques and approaches in writing features for print newspapers and magazines.

Prof Pradeep Nair, Dean, School of Journalism Mass Communication and New Media inaugurated the event and talked about the importance of writing skills being the base of almost all job roles in the media industry.
