(2019-2020)

During the year 2019-20, the following activities were conducted under Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat (EBSB):

1) National Technology Day

a) 10th May 2019: HIET, Shahpur

Prof. B.C. Chauhan, Nodal Officer organized the function in collaboration with the Chairman Sh. Narender Rana, HIET Shahpur. Dr. S.B. Mishra, Retired Scientist from DRDO, who was involved the Shakrti-98, Atomic Explosion Programme of India with Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, delivered a lecture and shared his experiences with the students. Exhibition on the models of Science was also organized.

b) 13th May 2019: TAB Dharamshala

2) EBSB Students Exchange Programme

a) 4th Feb.-8th Feb.: CUHP Students visit to CU Kerala

As part of this Students' Exchange Programme, 29 students and 2 faculty members commenced the journey on 1st of February 2020 from Central University of Himachal Pradesh campus in Dharamshala in Himachal Pradesh and returned back on 11th February 2020.

b) 5th March -8th March : CUK Students visit to CUHP

As part of this Students' Exchange Programme, CUK Students Group of 50 students and 02 faculty members.
