### Discussion and Resolution

Resolve: All the resolves on the agenda items of the fifth BOS meeting are approved by the members.

It was further suggested that meaning and benefits of Plagiarism must be included so that students know and it would be be ficial to the scholar in the Ph.D. Course work of RFA -604 Research and Publication Ethics in Unit -3 for the session 2022-2023. (Attached Annexure A)

Nomenclature of the courses of BFA and MFA degrees are revised to avoid repetition of same Course titles (Attached Annexure 1). Subject experts suggested that each faculty member must teach at least one theory course along with their practical courses as UGC stress on research work.

Revised syllabi of BFA( Sculpture) and (Painting)(Semester 1 to 8) including Course Structure, Credit Template, comprehensive Course submission, Examination Scheme, etc, approved (Attached Annexure 2).
- Revision of Master of Fine Arts in Sculpture(Sem-1 to 4) including Course Structure, Credit Template, comprehensive Course content, submission, Examination Scheme, etc. considered and approved (Attached Annexure 3)

Resolve: All members approved the entry and exists option in the BFA (Painting) and BFA (Sculpture) Programmes in Semester-2, 4 and 8 for the reason that BFA is professional ee of 4 years consists of 8 semesters so Entry Exist is not possible at the level 7 after completing Six semesters.(Attached Annexure 4)

Resolve: Practical examinations of Monsoon (odd) semester will be evaluated only by two internal examiners appointed by the Head of the Department whereas in Spring (even) semester, Evaluation of Term End Examination will be carried out on the basis of conduction of Practical examination and submission through one internal examiner and one external examiner. A student shall submit a request for Research Proposal on chosen topic of concern specialization. Subject experts recommended

that Academic Advisory Committee (AAC) members of the department shall allot a teacher as a supervisor for assisting in the development of synopsis and further progression. The synopsis of the research shall be approved by the AAC on the recommendation of the supervisor. Only a full time regular/contractual teacher with Ph D can act as a supervisor for PG Dissertations.Non PhD faculty members are advised to take Dissertations/Project Supervision or Guidance at UG level if they have knowledge of research work.

It was also advised that Panel of external examiners be approved in the Board of Studies before forwarding the same to the School Board.
