Our team helped people to make use of these schemes to build toilets.

Q1. Do you know about SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN ?

Ans. YES (75%) NO(25%)

Q2. Is the Toilet available in the house?

Ans. YES(80%) NO(20%)

Q3. Did Gram Panchayat or Municpal Corporation took any steps under SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN?

Ans. YES(66%) NO(34%)

Q4. Did the facilities or schemes provided by Govt. reaching to your village or households?

Ans. YES(53.85%) NO(46.15%)

Q5. Does Gram Panchayat or Municpal corporation talks on the issues related with "Cleanliness" ?

Ans. YES(40%) NO (60%)

Q6. Does the locality, streets and roads get cleaned often?

Ans. YES(54.5%) NO(45.5%)

Q7. What do you think about the cleanliness of your locality?

Ans. SATISFACTORY(60%) NOT SATISFACTORY AND NEEDS IMPROVEMENT(40%)
