The event was organized for the differently-abled persons to give an LN-4 prosthetic hand which was free of cost. Gift of Mobility event is a joint effort of 'Ratna Nadhi Charitable Trust', 'Rotary Club of Dharamshala (RID3070)', 'Rotary Club of Poona Downtown (RID3131)', 'Ellen Meadows Prosthetic Hand Foundation of USA' and the event was sponsored by Deputy Commissioner Kangra Dr. Nipun Jindal (IAS). Also, the volunteers from across India participate and help the beneficiaries. The president of this event is Rtn. Sangram Guleria, Secretary Rtn. Ajay Sharma, Project Chairman Rtn. V.S. Dr. Shveta Sharma, Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, Central University of Himachal Pradesh with her two Scholars named Sansar Chand and Sankita Sharma actively joined the event. They were interviewing the beneficiaries and gave instant counselling to the beneficiaries. So that the beneficiaries can get maximum benefit out of this event by motivating them to make best use of it. The team of Rotary Club Downtown, Poona was full of positivity and energy. They interacted with the Scholars and gave them the responsibility to follow up these cases and make sure that these hands are used and are not kept in a cupboard. The beneficiaries include people of different generations from old age to children. The age group of beneficiaries was between the age of 4 years to 65 years. The incidence of losing an arm was because of an accident and there were few cases who didn't have their arm by birth. The beneficiaries were given the training of using the artificial limb and were counseled to do whatever they want to do by showing some motivational videos in which people using artificial limbs were doing

everything. In this event, the total number of beneficiaries were around 30 and most of the beneficiaries were from different areas of kangra district of Himachal Pradesh whereas few of the beneficiaries were from Jammu and Punjab too. At the end of the event, the team of Rotary Club of Dharamshala presented a book as a token of love. The book was wrapped in a eco-friendly bag with a deep message of promoting the eco-friendly bags which are made by destitute women of slum areas.
