A survey of households below Poverty Line in Dehra in collaboration with Sewa Bharti

Students of MSW Semester I of the Department of Social Work in collaboration with Sewa Bharti, Dehra conducted a survey of households Below Poverty Line (BPL) between 1 January, 2022 to 22 January, 2022 as part of their winter-internship program. Based on a vulnerability index, the students identified twenty-two households under the extremely vulnerable category. The survey was followed by interaction with the members of each household. During this interaction, the students along with the volunteers of Sewa Bharti, scholars and faculty members of the department enquired about the problems faced by these families and the benefits received by them from government schemes. Further, blankets were also distributed to the old and sick members of these households.

WHO Pulse Polio Monitoring Programme as External Monitors

The Department of Social Work, Central University of Himachal Pradesh (CUHP) located at Dehra Sapt Sindhu Campus, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh in collaboration with SMO Shimla, World Health Organization (WHO) organized Intensive Pulse Polio Monitoring programme (IPPI) in which students pursuing Masters of Social Work were selected for monitoring the programme as External Monitors. A training programme for the students of MSW Semester II and IV was held in Dehra on 09th February 2022. After the training the students were assigned the task of External Monitors for four consecutive days.



The field monitoring this year was scheduled from 27th February to 02nd March 2022 in which the selected students were posted at different locations in Himachal Pradesh. In four days, different monitoring tasks were assigned to the students like Booth Monitoring for first day, followed by High Risk Areas (HRAs) monitoring, House to House visits and Transit sites monitoring on the last day of the programme. Stipend of INR 1200/- was also given to each pair of External Monitors along with a travelling allowance and certificate for participation.

The Chief Guest was Prof. Narayan Singh Rao, Dean, School of Social Sciences and Resource persons were Mr Jayant Bhagat, Director, Central Groundwater Board and Dr Sanjay Pandey, Scientist, Central Groundwater Board, Dharamshala.

As part of the programme a lecture by the Resource Person and Field Visit at Check dam near Nakerkhad, Jwalamukhi road, Himachal Pradesh was conducted. Prof. Rao told that such sessions play an important role in enhancing the learning of the students. Mr Jayant Bhagat, Director, Central Groundwater Board shared that in HP groundwater level is good and sustaining this level of groundwater is very important. CGWB is playing a pivotal role, as stated by Mr Bhagat. Dr Sanjay Pandey, Scientist, Central Groundwater Board stated that students especially social work students should be sensitized about technical aspects related to groundwater conservation; so that they can be change agents for a sustainable tomorrow. This activity was

followed by the cleanliness drive at the field location at check dam near Nakerkhad, Jwalamukhi road, Himachal Pradesh. Faculty members, research scholars with MSW Semester II and IV students participated in the day long programme.

Initiation of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan by Department of Social Work

Subsequent to the appointment of Dr Shashi Punam as the University Nodal Officer of the *Unnat Bharat Abhiyan*, five villages were adopted near the Sapt Sindhu Parisar, Dehra under this campaign. The Department of Social Work decided to send the MSW Semester I students and research scholars undergoing course work to these villages as part of their concurrent field work. The students were instructed to apply basic participatory research techniques like transect walk, community mapping and resource mapping in these villages. The faculty members assisted the students in building initial rapport with the villagers. The five villages are: Snoot, Barwara, Gher, Bongta, and Shivnath. The department has decided to involve the villagers in the future events being organised by the Department.

Role of Youth, Police & Communities in Disasters and Forest Fire Management



To develop capacities of all the stakeholders in general and local communities in particular to cope with disasters and carry out awareness campaigns in their respective districts right up to village level. To cooperate and encourage people to face the problems and contribute to the agencies in involved in relief works during disasters.
- > To empower youths to participate in the field of disaster management.




Various online sessions held for three days covering variety of topics like Special Address: Disaster Resilience in Himachal Pradesh; Role of Communities in Hazard, Risk and Vulnerability analysis; Role of Police in Community based Disaster Management; Role of Police in Forest Fire Management; Disaster Risk Management – A Community based Participatory Approach; Forest Fire Management in India: An Overview on Community Participation in Forest Fire; Causes of Landslides: Effects and Prevention in Himachal Pradesh; Forest Fire and Measure to Control: Overview; Glacial Lake Outburst Floods in Himalayas (GLOF), Guidelines for Disaster Resilience and Role of Youth in Himalayan Region; Vulnerability of Himalayan Community to Climate Hazard and Risk Assessment in the Himalayan Region; Discussion on Hazard Risk Vulnerability Profile of the HP region and institutional mechanisms. All the sessions were followed by question answers sessions respectively. Speakers discussed disaster management awareness on a community level in Himachal Pradesh, as well as an introduction to disaster management and recommendations for a safer, more resilient, and dynamic society in the Himalayan area.


Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan organized 'Nashe se Azadi' - National Youth and Students Interaction Program





Signature Campaign on "Beti Bachao Beti Padhao"

As part of celebrations of Foundation Week of Central University of Himachal Pradesh, The Department of Social Work initiated a Signature Campaign on the topic "Beti Bachao Beti Padhao in collaboration with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, Red Cross Society. In 2015, the Indian government introduced the Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme to address concerns of gender discrimination and women empowerment in the country. The name Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao translates to 'Save the girl child, educate the girl child'. The scheme aims to educate citizens against gender bias and improve efficacy of welfare services for girls. It was launched with an initial funding of Rs. 100 crore The Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Yojana aims to achieve the following goals:

- Improve the child sex ratio
- Ensure gender equality and women empowerment
- Prevent gender-biased, sex selective elimination

- Ensure survival and protection of the girl child
- Encourage education and participation of the girl child.




