

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. Under this, our department has got a project entitled 'Opportunities of Livelihood to Check the Migration from Hills in Himachal Pradesh' from NITI Aayog. The aim of the project to survey the different areas of the HP to document the socio-economical data and to check the reasons behind the migration from the hills. This project will also be helpful for identifying the challenges prevailing there so that policies for minimizing the same can be prepared and implemented.



Public Awareness programs

The faculty members of Department of Plant Science are actively involved in carrying out various public/farmers awareness events through a number of invited lectures and TV talks. During the year 2020-2021, the departmental faculty delivered lectures, organized webinars and conducted field tour on different occasions and locations.

Organized Online International webinar on "Innovation in crop improvement under changing climatic conditions" at Central University of Himachal Pradesh on 28-05-2020 to aware the people about the various approaches to be used for crop improvement.



Plant diversity is currently face the threat of extinction due to a variety of devastating activities, including, over-harvesting and over exploitation, destructive agricultural and forestry practices, urbanization, environmental pollution, land-use changes, exotic invasive species, global climate change, and more. Therefore there is need to explore the various approaches for the conservation of the plant biodiversity. Botanical gardens are one of an important resource for studying and conservation of these plants, as well as making the world's plant species diversity known to the public.

In order to establish the Botanical Garden at CUHP, an expert committee from Department of Plant Science and University visited the Jadrangal area of Dharamshala on 20-07-2020 (Site of University Establishment) and took stock of the situation there.

Context- Department of health research Govt. of India awarded young Scientist grant of Rs. 35,50,500 to Dr. Dixit Sharma for carrying research work on neglected and tropical diseases of north west Himalayan region. The project will also promote awareness programs among rural population because they are mostly infected by disease such as Scrub typhus and other tick born disease.

Practice-Awareness programs are organized among small group in different endemic areas of disease.

Outcome- The people come to know about these ticks born infectious disease which were prevalent in region and also about their preventing measure.

Problem- The main problem occurs during this work is local language.
