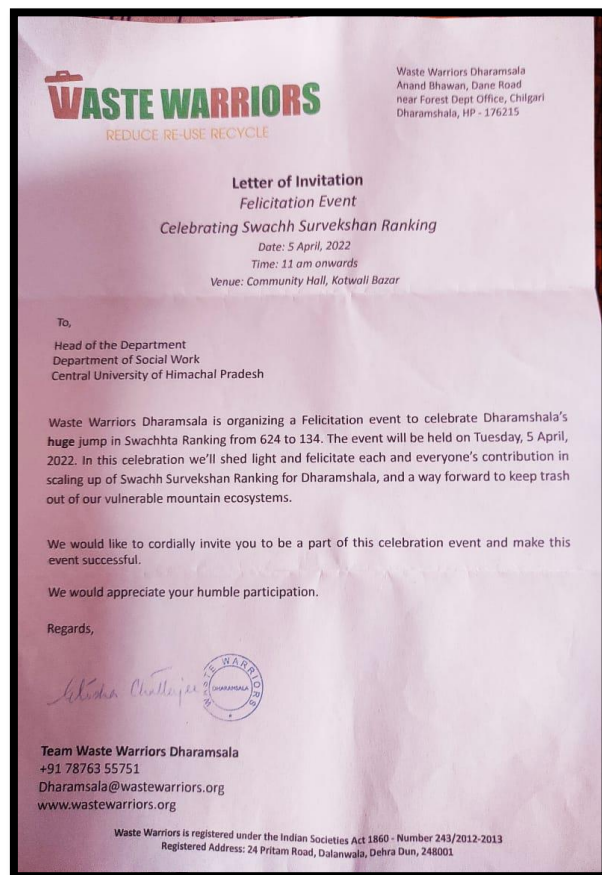

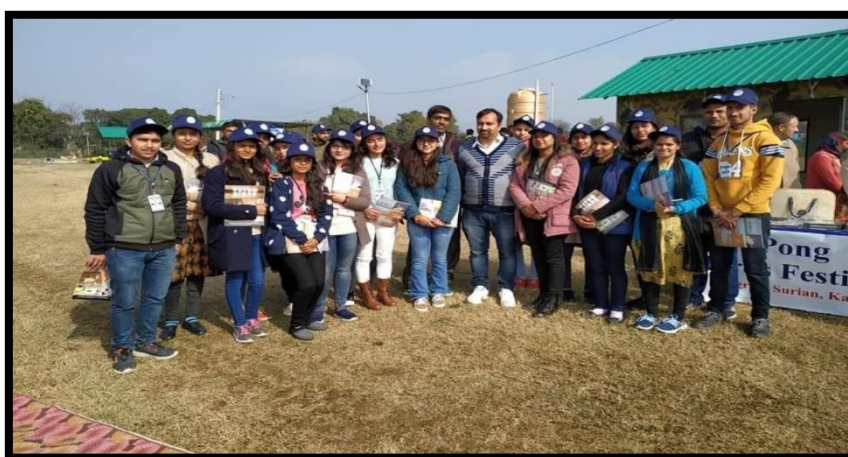

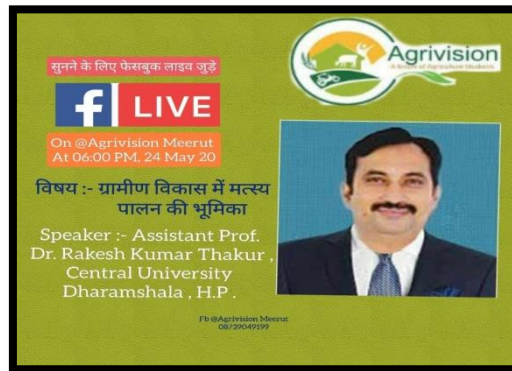

**विज्ञान की भारतीय अवधारणा**  
 (27-28 फरवरी 2018)

- विज्ञान मानव जीवन में एवं होने वाले विकास का मूलभूत आधार है। वैज्ञानिक दृष्टिकोण किसी भी राष्ट्र के उन्नयन में एक महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाता है। भारतवर्ष में विज्ञान अतिवैरागिक काल से ही प्रचलित है। इस बात के कई साक्ष्य हमारी संस्कृति एवं कई ऐतिहासिक घटनाओं में मिलते हैं। विज्ञान की भारतीय अवधारणा के वैज्ञानिक साक्ष्य हमारे पौराणिक ज्ञान की परंपरा हमारे वेदों और अन्य ग्रंथों के रूप में पाए जा सकते हैं। भारतीय ऋषि-मुनियों ने प्रकृति के रहस्यों का अन्वेषण करने में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान दिया है। इनमें प्रमुख हैं - कणाद (अणु की अवधारणा), सुक्रत (चिकित्सा, आयुर्वेद), आर्यभट्ट (गुरुत्वाकर्षण, अक्षरेख, एवं कई खगोलीय रहस्यों पर शोध), ब्रह्मगुप्त (गणित), इत्यादि।
- आधुनिक विज्ञान में भी भारत के कई महान वैज्ञानिकों का महत्वपूर्ण योगदान रहा है। चंद्रशेखर वेंकटरमन, होमी भाबहा, सत्येन्द्र नाथ बोस, श्रीनिवास रामानुजन, ए.पी.जे. अब्दुल कलाम, हरगोविंद खोरना, सुब्रह्मण्यम चंद्रशेखर, विजय लक्ष्मी, मेघनाथ साहू, प्रफुल्ल चट्टोपाध्याय, बी.एन. सहाय, सर मोहनलाल विवेकानंद, जगदीश चन्द्र बोस, सतीश धवन, इत्यादि। ऐसे विद्वानों और महान मानव हैं जिन्होंने आधुनिक विज्ञान में अविस्मरणीय योगदान दिया है।
- विज्ञान के प्रसार-प्रसार एवं प्रसार में वैज्ञानिक स्वभाव अनिवार्य रूप से उत्प्रेरक के चंद्रशेखर वेंकटरमन द्वारा दिए गए रमन-प्रभाव की धारणा को स्मरण करते हुए 28 फरवरी को प्रति वर्ष भारत में राष्ट्रीय विज्ञान दिवस का आयोजन किया जाता है। इस वर्ष हिमाचल प्रदेश केंद्रीय विश्वविद्यालय के सभी विज्ञान संकाय 27 एवं 28 फरवरी को दो दिवसीय **विज्ञानोत्सव** का आयोजन कर रहे हैं। इस वर्ष के विज्ञानोत्सव का विषय **विज्ञान की भारतीय अवधारणा** रखा गया है। इस आयोजन में व्याख्यान देने हेतु प्रसिद्ध विषय-विशेषज्ञ आमंत्रित किये जा रहे हैं और व्याख्यान हेतु उप-विषय निम्नलिखित हैं -

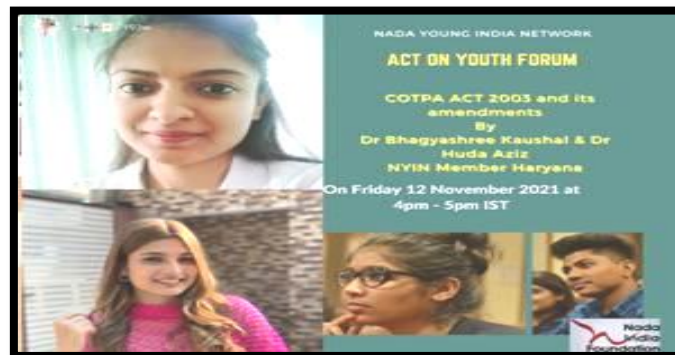




- **A Series Of Activities Organized On Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA)**

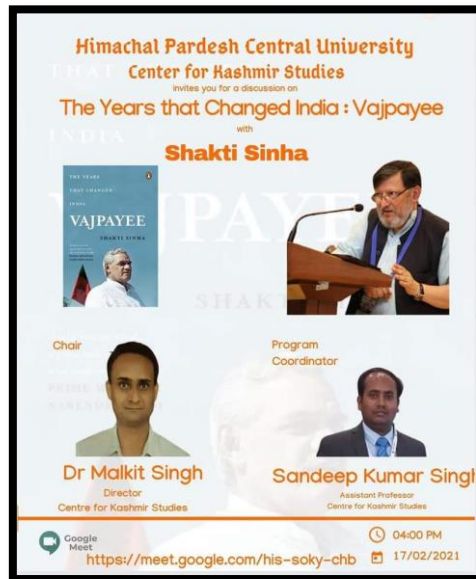

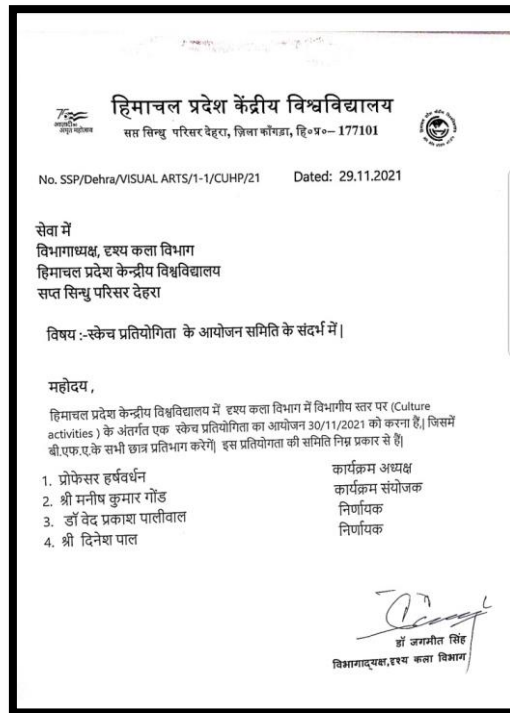
