## Report: Action Taken Based On Feedback (2020-21)

The department of Journalism & Mass Communication, School of Journalism, Mass Communication and New Media organized a meeting to deliberate upon the feedback received from the students of the department. The meeting was chaired by the Head of the Department and attended by all the faculty members. The members deliberated at length about various suggestions received from the alumni and the students of the department regarding the syllabus, pedagogical approaches and extra/co-curricular activities. It was unanimously decided by the members that the courses offered to the students of the department should be enhanced by incorporating the feedback of the students and keeping in view the framework of the NEP-2020. One of the major suggestions of the students was that the Department should endeavour to increase industry interactions and organize more skill development / industry training sessions. To address the suggestions to conduct more industry interactions and events, it was decided that more industry interactions, events and training sessions shall be organized during the next academic session.

In order to improve the industry interactions and understanding of the students, it was decided that the following events during the session:

**Film Screening and Writing workshop:** To improve students ability to critically appreciate films, it was decided that film screenings and film review writing workshops be organized in collaboration with the Dharamshala International Film Festival.

To improve the industry interaction, as per the feedback of the alumni, it was decided that industry experts (experienced journalists from mainstream media – both English and Hindi and academicians) be invited to interact with the students.

To address the feedback related to bringing more inter-disciplinary interactions in relevant courses, it was decided that interaction events with faculty members from other departments of the university be set up in case of courses where such relevant inter-disciplinary expertise is available.

Another feedback received from the students was regarding inclusion of more skill-oriented courses in the syllabus. This suggestion was appreciated by all the members present during the meeting and it was decided to include courses on data journalism, practical media production, etc. in the course.

The feedback from the alumni also suggested the need to consider student choice also in student allotment for faculty-guided activities. To address this concern, it was decided that student allotment for dissertation supervision and other faculty-guided activities will be based on students' choice and student merit instead of relying on random allotment.

कार्रवाई रिपोर्ट 2020-21

फरवरी 2021 में आईक्यूएसी द्वारा सभी हितधारकों की प्रतिक्रिया का विश्लेषण और चर्चा की गई। फीडबैक समिति ने विभिन्न हितधारकों से प्राप्त प्रतिक्रियाओं का विश्लेषण किया और आईक्यूएसी के साथ सक्रिय चर्चा में एक रिपोर्ट तैयार की।

आईक्यूएसी ने पाठ्यक्रम वितरण प्रक्रियाओं और ढांचागत सुविधाओं के बारे में निष्कर्षों और सिफारिशों के साथ विश्वविद्यालय काउंसिल के समक्ष फीडबैक रिपोर्ट प्रस्तुत की। आईक्यूएसी ने देखा कि अल्पसंख्यक छात्र मूल्यांकन प्रणाली की पारदर्शिता से संतुष्ट नहीं हैं, अतः एचओडी और शिक्षकों को उचित सुझाव देकर इस मुद्दे को संबोधित किया। समस्याओं पर चर्चा करने का वातावरण उत्तरदाताओं के अनुकूल नहीं है, इसलिए IQAC इन मुद्दों का समाधान खोजने के मिशन में है, ताकि वर्तमान और भूतपूर्व छात्रों के बीच का बंधन बना रहे।

### कार्रवाई की रिपोर्ट - छात्र प्रतिक्रिया

छात्रों से एकत्रित फीडबैक इंगित करता है कि छात्र कॉलेज में प्रचलित प्रणाली से संतुष्ट हैं। वास्तव में केंद्रीय विश्वविद्यालय हिमाचल प्रदेश का उद्देश्य ज्ञान के पारंपरिक और पिछले क्षेत्रों में उच्च शिक्षा, शोध, अनुसंधान और व्यावसायिक क्षेत्रों को बढ़ावा देकर उत्कृष्टता प्रदान करना है।

### की गई कार्रवाई पर विचार करने के लिए बिंदु

1. पाठ्यक्रम पूरा करना: 10% छात्रों ने फीडबैक दिया कि शिक्षकों द्वारा पूरा किया गया पाठ्यक्रम पूरा करने का मिशन असफल रहा। 1. कॉलेज के आईक्यूएसी ने इस मुद्दे पर चर्चा की और संबंधित विभागों को शिक्षकों से पाठ्यक्रम प्रतियोगिता रिपोर्ट की निगरानी और तैयार करने की सिफारिश की।
2. शिक्षक छात्रों को पाठ्येतर, सह-पाठ्यक्रम गतिविधियों और अनुसंधान परियोजनाओं में भाग लेने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करता है: 9% छात्रों ने टिप्पणी की कि शिक्षक प्रोत्साहन के संबंध में अपर्याप्त था।

### पाठ्येतर और सह-पाठ्यचर्या संबंधी गतिविधियाँ:-

2. आईक्यूएसी ने इस मामले पर चर्चा की और शिक्षकों को छात्रों के कौशल और प्रतिभा के उत्थान के लिए विभिन्न पाठ्येतर और सह-पाठ्यचर्या का आयोजन करने के लिए प्रेरित किया।

3. शारीरिक, भावनात्मक और सीखने की चुनौतियों का सामना करने में छात्रों की मदद करें: 11% छात्रों की राय थी कि शिक्षक शारीरिक, भावनात्मक और मानसिक चुनौतियों का सामना करने में, या मदद करने में सक्षम नहीं थे।

3. आईक्यूएसी ने इस मुद्दे की बारीकी से जांच की और शिक्षकों को भावनात्मक और मानसिक अशांति वाले छात्रों को परामर्श सत्र प्रदान करने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया।

4. छात्रों को उनकी ताकत का एहसास करने में मदद करता है:

11% छात्रों ने व्यक्त किया कि शिक्षक छात्रों की ताकत को पहचानने में सक्षम नहीं थे।

4. विकसित चुनौती पर IQAC द्वारा गंभीरता से चर्चा की गई और शिक्षकों से छात्रों की बारीकी से जांच करने, उन्हें समूहों में विभाजित करने और उनकी ताकत और क्षमताओं को समझने की सिफारिश की गई।

5. 7% छात्रों ने दावा किया कि संस्थान लिंग के बावजूद छात्रों को अवसर और सुविधाएं प्रदान करता है, जो ठीक नहीं है।

5. मामले के संदर्भ में, आईक्यूएसी ने विभागों को व्यवस्थित करने की सिफारिश की ताकि इस प्रकार की भावना विद्यार्थियों के दिलों में न पनपे। छात्रों, विशेष रूप से लिंग के बावजूद छात्रों को अवसर प्रदान करने में लिंग तटस्थता और उनसे लिंग के बावजूद सभी को अवसर प्रदान करने का आग्रह किया।

### की गई कार्रवाई की रिपोर्ट - पूर्व छात्रों की प्रतिक्रिया

पूर्व छात्रों से एकत्र किए गए फीडबैक से संकेत मिलता है कि विश्वविद्यालय ने उनकी आकांक्षाओं को पूरा किया है और विश्वविद्यालय में अकादमिक के साथ-साथ गैर-शैक्षणिक मामलों में भी उत्कृष्टता प्राप्त करने की क्षमता है। पाठ्यक्रम में करियर ओरिएंटेशन और रोजगार हासिल करने के लिए इसकी पर्याप्तता के बारे में पूर्व छात्रों की प्रतिक्रिया में, 10% पूर्व छात्रों ने दावा किया कि कॉलेज ने नौकरी हासिल करने के लिए आवश्यक सुविधाएं प्रदान नहीं की हैं। अवसरों और सुविधाओं में लिंग तटस्थता के संबंध में पूर्व छात्रों से प्राप्त फीडबैक से पता चला कि 4% पूर्व छात्रों ने दावा किया कि संस्थान अवसरों और सुविधाओं में लिंग तटस्थता के मुद्दे को संबोधित करने में विफल रहा है। पूर्व छात्रों से प्राप्त प्रतिक्रिया इंगित करती है कि बुनियादी ढांचा और प्रयोगशाला सुविधाएं पर्याप्त नहीं हैं। 7% माना जाता है कि संस्थान में अपर्याप्त सुविधाएं हैं।

IQAC ने मामलों पर चर्चा की और इसने विभागों को मूल्य वर्धित / प्रमाणपत्र पाठ्यक्रम आयोजित करने की सिफारिश करने का निर्णय लिया जो छात्रों की भविष्य की जरूरतों को पूरा कर सकते हैं।

आईक्यूएसी ने अवसरों और सुविधाओं में लिंग तटस्थता पर चर्चा की और विभागों को सलाह दी कि वे लैंगिक तटस्थता पर सेमिनार और कार्यशालाएं करवाएँ, जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित करें। उनसे सभी छात्रों को लिंग के बावजूद अवसर प्रदान करने का आग्रह किया। इस प्रकार आईक्यूएसी छात्रों को ऐसे अलुमनाई से सीखने और उनसे प्राप्त फीडबैक से विश्वविद्यालय परिवार की ओर से उनको मंच प्रदान करता है, ताकि आने वाली अन्य गतिविधियों में सुधार किया जा सके।

की गई कार्रवाई की रिपोर्ट - शिक्षकों की प्रतिक्रिया

शिक्षकों से एकत्र की गई प्रतिक्रिया को अत्यधिक सकारात्मक प्रतिक्रिया मिली। परीक्षा से पहले पाठ्यक्रम को समय पर पूरा करने के संबंध में, 21% शिक्षकों ने टिप्पणी की कि वे निर्धारित समय के भीतर पाठ्यक्रम को पूरा करने में सक्षम नहीं थे। नए विकास को पेश करने के समय के बारे में, 16% शिक्षकों ने दावा किया कि नए विकास को पेश करने के लिए समय अपर्याप्त था। प्रश्न पत्र पैटर्न की प्रतिक्रिया से छात्रों का पूरा ज्ञान प्राप्त होता है, 17% शिक्षकों ने दावा किया कि प्रश्न पत्र पैटर्न छात्रों के पूर्ण ज्ञान को प्राप्त करने के लिए उपयुक्त नहीं था। बुनियादी ढांचे और प्रयोगशाला सुविधाओं के संबंध में, 14% ने दावा किया कि संस्थान में अपर्याप्त बुनियादी ढांचा और प्रयोगशाला सुविधाएं हैं।

परीक्षा से पहले पाठ्यक्रम को समय पर पूरा करने के संबंध में:-

आईक्यूएसी ने दावा किया कि पाठ्यक्रम को समय पर पूरा करने के लिए एक कार्य योजना तैयार की जानी चाहिए। नए विकास को शुरू करने के समय के संबंध में आईक्यूएसी ने एक समय सारिणी बनाने का निर्णय लिया। आईक्यूएसी प्रश्न पत्र पैटर्न का मूल्यांकन करने और संबंधित प्राधिकारी को आवश्यक परिवर्तनों की सिफारिश करने की सिफारिश की। साथ ही जरूरत के हिसाब से जरूरी इंफ्रास्ट्रक्चर खरीदने का भी फैसला किया।

की गई कार्रवाई की रिपोर्ट - माता-पिता की प्रतिक्रिया:-

अभिभावकों से एकत्रित फीडबैक से पता चलता है कि विश्वविद्यालय छात्रों की आवश्यकताओं को पूरा करने में सक्षम था और वे विश्वविद्यालय में मौजूद व्यवस्था से संतुष्ट हैं। संस्था द्वारा आयोजित उत्सवों, आयोजनों और पाठ्येतर गतिविधियों के संदर्भ में माता-पिता के फीडबैक से पता चलता है कि 7% अभिभावकों ने दावा किया कि संस्था पर्याप्त गतिविधियों का आयोजन नहीं कर रही है। छात्रों के लिए उनकी समस्याओं पर चर्चा करने के लिए अनुकूल वातावरण के बारे में, 7% अभिभावकों ने दावा किया कि संस्थान छात्रों को उनकी समस्याओं पर चर्चा करने के लिए वातावरण प्रदान करने में सक्षम नहीं था। किसी भी प्रश्न के संबंध में अधिकारियों की पहुंच में आसानी के बारे में प्रतिक्रिया, 7% ने अपनी अस्वीकृति दिखाई। वार्डों को उनकी ताकत और चुनौतियों के स्तर की पहचान करके प्रोत्साहन प्रदान करने के संबंध में, 10% ने असंतोष व्यक्त किया।

आईक्यूएसी ने संस्थान द्वारा आयोजित उत्सवों, कार्यक्रमों और पाठ्येतर गतिविधियों के संदर्भ में इस मामले पर चर्चा की और छात्रों को समृद्ध करने के लिए विभिन्न गतिविधियों को आयोजित करने के लिए विभागों की सिफारिश करने का निर्णय लिया। छात्रों की समस्याओं पर चर्चा करने के लिए संस्थान के अनुकूल वातावरण के संबंध में आईक्यूएसी ने विभागों को छात्रों के उत्थान के लिए उपयुक्त वातावरण प्रदान करने की सिफारिश की। किसी भी प्रश्न के संबंध में अधिकारियों की पहुंच में आसानी के संबंध में आईक्यूएसी ने संबंधित अधिकारियों को आवश्यकतानुसार करने की सिफारिश की। वार्डों को उनकी ताकत और चुनौतियों के स्तर की पहचान करके प्रोत्साहन प्रदान करने के संबंध में आईक्यूएसी ने सुझाव दिया कि विभागों को छात्रों को प्रेरणा प्रदान करनी चाहिए, उनके कौशल और प्रतिभा की पहचान करनी चाहिए, ताकि उनकी प्रतिभा में निखार आ सके और वो आत्मनिर्भर बन सकें।

### **Action Taken Report-Alumni Feedback**

The Post Graduate programme is satisfactory as per industry standards. The department has to invited professional teachers to deliver a lecture on various historical aspects and other areas. Also department offer teaching assistanceship to mediocre PG students. The syllabus is enhanced by including more electives. The question papers of internal assessment and end term examination is prepared on empirical development. Department gave opportunity to PG students to give mock lectures. Also best project practice initiated in the department. To increase participation tutorial classes, surprise tests are introduced. A tutorial class was more interactive and participative. This course is great for thinking about the conceptual issues surrounding history it takes the work you have done at department and really elevates it to the next level. It's quite challenging at times but definitely rewarding.

### **Action Taken Report- Teachers Feedback**

The department all faculty members indulge in curriculum enrichment takes feedback from students each semester and caters to student diversity. Takes interest in promoting opportunities for experiential learning for students. Also facilitates the students' cognitive, social and emotional growth through teacher student mentoring process. Identifies strengths of students and encourages them with appropriate level of challenges. Also makes efforts to large scale engage students in review and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process. Encourages student to participation in co-curricular activities, puts specific efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability and financial independence. In addition systematically encourages reflective practices in the pedagogy and assignments.

### **Action taken Report-Parents Feedback**

To get an overall idea on the syllabi of various courses offered by the university maintains an departmental level feedback report. Every year feedback on curriculum is collected mostly from final year students as they have an overall idea of the curriculum.
